



The Robotics Society-Student Chapter- Activity for Learning and Enriching (TRS- SCALE) Call for Proposal 2025-26

The Robotics Society (TRS), India encourages the TRS Student Chapters (TRS-SC) to submit proposals for conducting robotics activity/ workshops that focus on hands-on or novel application domains of robotics for learning and enriching the skills of students. TRS-SC faculty advisors are encouraged to submit/ apply for financial support for conducting the activity in the TRS-SC.

The steps to be followed by TRS and TRS-SC are given below, along with important dates:

1	Call for Proposals from TRS-SC is announced by TRS	Phase-I: Jul. 1, 2025 Phase-II: Jan. 1, 2026
2	TRS-SC Fills up the Proposal (Annexure I) and submits to TRS	Phase-I: July 31 , Aug. 15 2025 Phase-II: Jan. 31, 2026
3	TRS shortlists and announces the accepted proposals	Phase-I: Aug. 15 , Aug. 20, 2025 Phase-II: Feb. 15, 2026
4	TRS-SC to conduct the proposed activity	Phase-I: Sept. 1, 2025 – Dec. 31, 2025 Phase-II: Apr. 1, 2026 – Jul. 31, 2026
5	TRS-SC to settle the financial accounts and submit a two-page completion report	Phase-I: Jan. 1-31, 2026 Phase-II: Sept. 1-30, 2026

The following are some of the generic guidelines that have to be followed by TRS-SC:

Producing a Call for Participation (CFP)

Organizers are responsible for publicity of the activity such as distributing the CFP to relevant newsgroups and mailing lists, and especially to potential audiences from the robotics community. Organizers are encouraged to maintain their own web site with updated information about the activity/ workshop.

Selecting participants

Workshop attendance is by invitation of the organizers. Selection of attendees will be made by the organizers on the basis of submissions. Workshop organizers should not charge any fee from the TRS-SC members.

Fund Transfer to Institute Account

Organizer will have to provide the account details of the Institute for transfer of fund by TRS. Proposal should indicate requirement of advance fund.

Utilization Certificate

An audited financial report including utilization certificate is to be submitted after completion of the activity/ workshop.
